Due to the high interest in Chess Club, we will group students by grade level in addition to setting up an on-line chess club.

#### **Club Information**

Chess sessions will begin the Week of September 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Dismissal Procedure**

Dismissal from Chess Club will be in the car loop starting at 4:00pm. Any student picked up after 4:00pm will be considered a "late pickup." There is no bus/van or daycare transportation provided. Please indicate if your child is a walker, car rider, bike rider or Champions.

#### Competitions

All chess club members are encouraged to compete in daily matches on the Chesskids app located on Launchpad. We will share information once it becomes available about mini tournaments with surrounding elementary schools. Also, we will offer the opportunity to purchase Chess Club T-shirts in October.

#### **Enrollment Procedure**

There is limited capacity for students per grade level. Students who are not initially chosen for Chess Club will be enrolled in the on-line chess club using the Chesskid program located on Launchpad. Each six weeks a new session will begin for beginner players. The sessions are as follows...

Session #2	Week of November 6 <sup>th</sup> – December 18 <sup>th</sup>
Session #3	Week of January 8 <sup>th</sup> -Feb 12 <sup>th</sup>
Session #4	Week of Feb 19 <sup>th</sup> – April 1 <sup>st</sup>
Session #5	Week of April 8 <sup>th</sup> – April 29 <sup>th</sup> (4 weeks only)

#### Removal

- 1. When three written warnings go home from the Chess coach about inappropriate behavior.
- 2. When the student creates a trend of absences, the third absence will release your spot to a person on the wait list.
- 3. When the student is picked up late more than twice.

#### Student Pledge

- 1. I will be in the cafeteria at 3:00 waiting for my Chess coach to pick me up.
- 2. I will be dismissed at 4:00 and I will be waiting at the car loop for pick-up, or I will go to Champions, or I have permission to walk/ride my bike home.
- 3. I will not run or be loud in the hallways before, during, or after Chess Club.
- 4. I will follow all of the classroom rules (show respect, be kind, be clean, and use the materials properly).
- 5. I understand that space is limited due to space and budget.
- 6. I understand that more than two absences or two late pick-ups will result in being released from Chess Club.
- 7. I understand that poor attitude and/or disruptive behavior will result in dismissal from Chess Club.
